

Let It Be FAQ

How do I purchase tickets?

Go to our website: letitbe.club and go to upcoming events, find your event you would like to attend, and purchase your tickets right on the website.

**Please note that we do not use any other ticketing systems other than hi.events.*

Purchasing tickets from any outside source other than our website is likely a scam.

Can I purchase tickets at the door?

Tickets may only be purchased at the door on the day of the show if the show is not sold out. Tickets should be purchased on our website any other time.

The show I want to attend is sold out, do you release tickets at the door?

We do not release extra tickets at the door and do not have a waiting list.

I can no longer attend the show I purchased tickets to. Do you offer refunds?

We do not offer refunds for any of our performances.

I purchased tickets, does that include a table?

No. Tickets get you into the performance. No matter what show you are attending we **always** recommend making a reservation.

*Reservations are answered between 8am-4pm during our administrative hours.

*If you do not receive a confirmation from someone on our team your reservation is not confirmed.

We are ADA compliant.

If a ramp is needed to enter the building please let the host inside know so they can set it up. Please make reservations ([Reservation Page – Let It Be](#)) so we can provide you with an accessible table. If you have other accommodations that you require please call us at 262-333-0800 and we would be happy to assist you.

I made a reservation. Do I stay at the same table for the performance? Are we able to order food during the show?

Yes, once you are seated for your reservation the table is yours for the remainder of the night. You may order food and drinks at your table with your server during the show.

We only want to stay for dinner not the show. When should we arrive?

We recommend arriving 2-3 hours before the show starts, depending on the performance. We ask that guests who are having dinner and are not staying for the show be finished at least 30 minutes before the show starts.

What is your reservation policy?

Reservations are held for 20 minutes before the table is released. Please include your phone number in your reservation so we can call you. We highly recommend calling if you are running late. Our host will call the number provided about 10 minutes after your scheduled reservation to check your status. If you don't arrive in the 20 minute window or our host cannot contact you the table will be released to someone else.

We'd like to have dinner before the show. What time should we arrive?

We typically recommend an hour and a half to two hours before the show depending on the performance. More popular shows such as The Taxmen, we always recommend coming in early as it gets busy very quickly.

I'd like to bring my kids to the show. Is Let It Be all ages?

Yes, we are all ages, as long as children are accompanied by an adult.

Tables are fully booked but I want to eat dinner, what do we do?

If tables are fully booked, we are at bar and standing room only. We do serve our full menu at the bar.

I would like to sit in front for the show. Am I able to request specific tables?

We no longer take table requests. Tables are picked at random.
